The thing I love most about the Come, Follow Me format is that it is designed for the youth to take an active role in their learning. We have designed our lesson helps to help facilitate a lesson full of thought and discussion, even if that means sending e-mails or texts.

HOW TO USE THIS PACKET WHEN HAVING CHURCH LESSONS AT HOME

In light of recent events and church being held only in our homes for awhile, we hope the ideas in this packet will help you as a parent and a teacher. If you are a paid member on our site, our Home & Family packets are included with your membership! You can use them in conjunction with the following ideas.

If you are a teacher:

We have been asked to continue our ministering. Part of our callings as teachers is ministering to those we teach. Most of the teaching will still be done in the homes, but there are things you can do to help your students continue to learn from you.

- **Send a handout/quote from the packet.** Use the new Gospel Living App if all of your students have access to it. (If your class hasn't set this up yet, you can e-mail or text. You could also print the handouts or prompts to mail or deliver if you live close by.) Include a question to get them thinking and studying their scriptures. (I've included an idea.) Encourage discussion among the group!
- **Use Google Hangout, Skype, or another free online meeting service.** Give plenty of notice to your class! If approved by your Bishop, you can do this on Sundays. Have an online meeting!
- **Use Social Media.** If you have an Instagram or Facebook group for your class, post a handout/quote. Ask a question or questions from the lesson. If on Instagram, you could do a story or IGTV and use polls and multiple choice questions using the apps functions.
- **Play Kahoot** (www.Kahoot.com). You can do this remotely, everyone just needs the login information. Use ideas and questions from the manual and this packet to help you! Again, make sure everyone has plenty of notice of when to start the game so they're all playing it together.

If you are a parent:

Many of the activities in this packet can easily be used for your family! Use these ideas along with your Family Come, Follow Me lesson time. Here are some ideas for older children and teenagers:

- Have your children work independently. Give them small assignments like the included worksheet or journal prompt. Come back together to discuss as a family.
- Have your children teach a section to the rest of the family!
- Do some of the group activities from the packet together as a family.
- Print some of the posters or handouts from the packet and display them around your home.
- Print the visual aids that include questions and make an assignment for your children. Set a time you will meet back together to share and discuss.
- For teenagers, specifically, many families are choosing to still have a lesson for their teens each Sunday. This is especially helpful if you have young children at home, too, and your family lessons are geared toward them. Use the ideas and printables in this packet to help you learn with your teen.

TRUTHS ABOUT SERVICE - MOSIAH 2:10-26

Send or give this activity to your youth. Ask them to read Mosiah 2:10-26 and answer the questions on the worksheet. This is a great activity to send along with the question below! Share a story about a time you overcame an obstacle to serve or share your testimony about serving God when we serve those around us.

SERVICE - MOSIAH 2:10-26

This question can be printed to display in your home or texted or emailed to class members. Ask your youth to read Mosiah 2:10-26. Encourage them to serve every day. Remind them that seemingly small acts of service count because they can mean a lot to the recipient.

Remind them that they may need to be creative in ways they serve as we're all at home. You could give them some ideas like sending a thank you email or text to someone, doing a chore for a sibling, helping a parent make dinner, or even leaving sidewalk chalk messages for their neighborhood! Teachers, you could invite your class to send you an email or text with some things they did to serve this week.
